UNESCO Codes

The Proposed international standard nomenclature for fields of science and technology was proposed in 1973 and 1974 by the Division of Science Policy and Statistics for Science and Technology of UNESCO and adopted by the Scientific Advisory Committee. This is a classification system widely used in knowledge management of research projects and dissertations. Categories are divided into three hierarchical levels:

- **Fields:** Referring to general sections. Encoded with two digits and comprises several disciplines.

- **Disciplines:** Provide an overview of specialty groups in Science and Technology. Encoded with four digits. Despite being different from each other disciplines with cross references, or within the same field, are considered to have common characteristics.
- **Subdisciplines:** Entries are the more specific elements of the nomenclature and represent the activities that take place within a discipline. Encoded with six digits. In turn, must correspond to individual specialties in science and technology.

- The Eigenfactor Project™ is a non-commercial academic research project sponsored by the Bergstrom lab in the Department of Biology at the University of Washington. We aim to use [recent advances in network analysis and information theory](#) to develop novel methods for evaluating the influence of scholarly periodicals and for mapping the structure of academic research. We are committed to broadly disseminating our research findings and technological developments, while respecting the confidentiality of the data sources we use. The Eigenfactor Project can be found on the web at Eigenfactor.org. The reported scores are,
 - **Eigenfactor™ Score (EF):** A measure of the overall value provided by all of the articles published in a given journal in a year; and
 - **Article Influence™ Score (AI):** a measure of a journal's prestige based on per article citations and comparable to *Impact Factor*.
